

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is a serious crime and is **strictly prohibited** at RGC, we are committed to provide a safe and supportive learning environment, and follow a zero-tolerance policy on ragging by any student.

This policy is in line with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, and subsequent amendments, and is enforceable under The Karnataka Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1989, Relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). Ragging includes any act that, harasses, intimidates, or humiliates a student, causes physical or psychological harm, disrupts the academic or personal life of any student.

Measures taken:

- All students and parents must submit an online anti-ragging undertaking at the time of admission.
- Regular awareness sessions and orientations are conducted.
- CCTV surveillance is maintained in hostels and campus premises.
- Separate hostel wardens and student counsellors are appointed.

An Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad are constituted with faculty, staff, and student representatives of their respective colleges. Any incident of ragging will be dealt with promptly and sternly.

Students may report incidents of ragging confidentially via , e-mail, and complaint Box placed in respective institutions.

Strict disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion, or filing an FIR, will be taken against offenders.
